

- Manuscript should be written in any version of Word text editor.
- Text with figures and tables should be prepared in the following format:
 - paper size – 17 by 24 cm
 - mirror margins:
 - up – 2.8 cm
 - down – 3.0 cm
 - inside – 2.0 cm
 - outsider – 2.5 cm
 - header – 2 cm
 - footer – 2.4 cm
- Text of the manuscript should be written using Times New Roman font, size 11 pt, line spacing 1.0, justified. Insert of the first line of paragraph is 1.25 cm. Hyphenation should be on.
- Title, authors' names and affiliations should be given at the beginning of the paper. Indicate the author for correspondence and provide his e-mail address.
- Chapters' titles should be numbered using Times New Roman, bold, 12 pt, line spacing 1.0, left-aligned, no hyphenation, no period, paragraph spacing: before 12 pt, after 6 pt.
- Subchapters' titles should be numbered: 1.1., 1.2, using Times New Roman, bold, 11 pt, line spacing 1.0, left-aligned, no hyphenation, no period, paragraph spacing: before 6 pt, after 6 pt.
- Equations should be centred and numbered (right-aligned), e.g.:

$$a + b = c \tag{1}$$

where:

a – ...

b – ...,etc.

- Figures should be placed in the text and their size should not exceed format given in point 2 and should be numbered. Titles should be formatted using Times New Roman, 10 pt, line spacing 1.0, left-aligned, no period, paragraph spacing: before 6 pt, after 0 pt, e.g.:

- Tables should be placed in the text and should not exceed size of the page given in point 2. Titles should be numbered and formatted (Times New Roman, 10 pt, line spacing 1.0, left-aligned), no period, paragraph spacing: before 0 pt, after 6 pt.:

Table 1. Table title

- Citations of literature references in the text should be noted in parentheses stating the author's name and year of publication of cited position. E.g. (Smith et al. 2012, Smith & Jones 2009, Jones 2013).
- The last chapter of the paper (not numbered) is **References** formatted using Times New Roman 10 pt, line spacing 1,0, justified, indentation 0 cm, hanging 0,75 cm. Names in alphabetical order. References should be given using APA format, e.g.:

References

Smith, C., Jones, A., Wilson, S. (2012). *Title*. City: Publisher.

Jones, A., & Wilson, S. (2009). Title. *Journal Name*, *Nr*, page-page.

Please pay special attention to correct spelling of names of authors and journals names, which is crucial in the process of citations indexing.

- At the end of paper, abstract and keywords should be given. Format is Times New Roman 10 pt, line spacing 1,0, justified, eg.:
